## CAETC Programs

*Program Development and Presentation* – the CAETC accepts all requests for HIV and Hepatitis education programs for health professionals. Clinical faculty and educators travel statewide.

*Clinical Training Program* – individualized HIV clinical mini-sabbatical experiences can be arranged in Denver for care providers.

*Treatment Updates* – annual spring and fall updates on new developments in managing HIV patients. Held at various sites statewide.

*Clinical Care of HIV-infected Women Conference* – through the Colorado Women's HIV Consortium, the CAETC co-sponsors this one-day program that addresses the impact of the HIV epidemic among women.
